RECOMMENDED PLAN FROM THE COMMITTEE: THE CREATION OF NEW KENT BROADBAND AUTHORITY

- Phase One:
 - 1(a):
 - Legal formation
 - creation of engineering plans
 - refined cost estimate
 - 1(b):
 - creation of Board of Directors
 - implementation timeline

Phase Two

- Installation of fiber ring connecting all government and school buildings
- Installation of fiber to anchor businesses

Phase Three

- Connections start to unserved and underserved areas of the county
- Could begin within one year of formation of Authority
- Could run simultaneously with Phase Four

Phase Four

- Connections available to previously served areas
- More efficient, less expensive than previous service

 Phases Two, Three, and Four have the potential to create upwards of 2 dozen construction jobs.

• The Broadband Authority will create approximately 12 jobs.

WHAT IS NEEDED TO START?

- Motion to authorize the legal creation of the Authority
- Motion to authorize \$200,000 for Phase One.
 - \$30-40,000 will be spent immediately
 - Legal Formation
 - Hire Nick Pascaretti on a Professional Services Contract
 - Draft Bylaws and Policies for the Authority
 - Recommendations for a Board of Directors for Authority

• Prior to spending the remaining \$160,000, the committee will return an engineering plan and final cost estimate for approval.

We estimate 30-60 days to return with this plan and estimate.

 Upon approved, funds will be available for use while the Board secures financing for remainder of project.

WHAT IS TOTAL COST?

- Estimate of \$7-8 million spread over several years
- May not reach that total before profits emerge
- Current plan shows Authority profitable in 3 years
- Incoming profits finance continued construction
- Payments to county begin by year 7
- Total county investment paid back in 10 years
- Revenue generator for county after investment is paid back
